District Veterinary Hospital (DVH)

A District Veterinary Hospital (DVH) functions at each district headquarter for providing Veterinary and Animal Husbandry services in the concerned district. There are 30 DVHs functioning in the Department. Each DVH is headed by a Veterinary Doctor in the rank of Deputy Director (OVS Group-A Senior Branch). He is assisted by another Additional Veterinary Assistant Surgeon for day-to-day management of works at Veterinary Hospital. The Veterinary Hospital works towards providing services in animal healthcare, breeding, immunisation, feeding and fodder technology and advisory services. It also works for facilitation of treatment of predominant diseases of livestock, by means of testing of different samples.

Under the 5T Charter- Transforming Veterinary Service Delivery in all District & Sub-Divisional Veterinary Hospitals, it has been planned to convert the 58 existing Veterinary Hospitals at District and Sub-Divisional Headquarters to Model Referral Hospitals by means of retrofitting / new constructions under the state plan scheme **“Strengthening of Livestock Service Infrastructures and Modernisation of Offices”** in phased manner.

Animal Helpline Ambulance (AHL) facility has been provided at 5 places namely Bhubaneswar, Cuttack, Ganjam, Sambalpur & Puri and these AHL are attached to District Veterinary Hospitals. A Mobile Ambulance has been provided at each place with team of Vets and Paravets. These AHL are meant to offer first aid and treatment to the stray animals mostly in case of emergency.

At each Veterinary Hospitals, DDLs (Disease Diagnostic Labs) have been set up to offer one-stop shop facility for all pathological tests as health care needs and advisory services to livestock owners.

MAJOR ACTIVITIES AT DISTRICT VETERINARY HOSPITAL :

01. Veterinary health check-up, treatment and issue of medicines for the healthcare of animals and birds.
02. Coordinate with municipal corporations/ municipality regarding control of dog menace, stray animals, functioning of the Kine house and Gosala.
03. Treatment of referral cases from other veterinary dispensaries of the district and nearby districts.
04. Maintains the Operation theatres and co-ordinates the surgical interventions of the sick animals by involving veterinarians with specialisation in surgery.
05. Organises health camps on Infertility management of cattle herds in the villages and municipality areas.
06. Conducts Artificial Insemination and follow up of calf born.
07. Supervision and monitoring of all state plan and central sector plan ARD schemes in Sadar Block.
08. Facilitate self-employment of youth under MKUY and other ongoing schemes.
09. Monitoring and supervision of sponsoring of application to various banks through AVAS/ VAS.
10. Monitoring and supervision of MVU programme.
11. Nodal Officer for the Animal Birth Control programme of the Municipal Corporation wherever applicable.
12. Coordinates with other departments like District Administration, Municipality, Fire, PWD, Forest, Police and Sadar Block.
13. Coordinates with NGOs and Animal Welfare Organisations.
14. Treasurer of the DLRDS.
15. Inspect the VDs and LACs under his/ her jurisdiction.
